

# Book of the Future: Dream

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## The Dream-vision

In a vision-dream of the 15<sup>th</sup> of March, 2008, I looked and saw a book floating in the heavenlies. The book was understood to be written before the beginning of time (at earth's re-creation).

The book was not shaped like an ordinary book but was shaped like a large 7-petal flower or mandala about 2.5 feet across and was bound together in the center to a 7-sided binding which became the central 'back' of the book. The leaves of the pages opened from the outside toward the center binding and each section of the book represented a different dimension of the future.

The book was 5-dimensional in that one could read from 1) front to back, 2) left to right, 3) right to left, 4) back to front and, 5) jump from section to section through the binding. This 5th and last approach seemed to transcend or leap from time period to time period but still the book made sense.

All pages were related to all other pages and it was written with word-symbols (glyphs) rather than lettered words. Sometimes the pages looked translucent with one fading into another. Whatever reading direction was chosen provided a different view of things to come. It was a book of the past, present and future.

The cover of the book was very ornate and sculptured in what looked like crafted leather. It was an amazing book to look at in that it is changed and adapted to the needs or interests of the user. It was very much alive!

As I looked, there opened before me a section of the book that was related to King David of Israel. As I viewed the page, the word-symbols would rewrite themselves mirroring the changing events/powers as they occurred in heaven and on earth.

Thus, the book was both static in that some events would occur without fail and dynamic in that some events can be changed and are changing. It was intelligent in that it rewrites itself as needed and thus is never out of date.

I then saw a page open and it revealed the line of King David to the line of Y'Shua. I heard it spoken by another (Angel? Elohim?) that "only the power of the blood of Y'Shua can change the outcome or rewrite the book." This right to make changes in the book was made possible when Messiah's blood hit the earth and so changed the course of history and the original future history written in the book.

At this juncture, the book came alive like a video and I saw an earthquake emanate from the cross as the blood of Y'Shua hit the earth that went out in all directions over the earth and changed the fabric of earth. I further understood that it is the faith of the 'saints' that also enables the blood to change the written word-symbols of the book.

## Interpretation

I then remembered as I was awakened, "They overcame the devil by the blood of the Lamb and the word of their testimony." The interpretation of this dream is clear. There are events of prophecy that cannot be changed and events of prophecy that are changeable through the faith of the Saints and by the blood of Y'Shua

The dream vision was in a setting similar to the visions of St John of Revelation - in the heavenlies so the location of the book appears to be in heaven. I believe there is a real book of this description in heaven. Perhaps called the "Book of Records."

I concluded that the key for the effective prayers of the saints is to determine what can

be changed and what cannot be changed and then pray for those events that can be changed for the sake of the Church and the Kingdom of God.

My impression is that the book was originally written with the input of Lucifer but through the event of the cross and shed blood of Y'Shua, the book is now being rewritten. In the original writing, the outcome of mankind was doomed to a subjugation to Lucifer. As the Messiah Y'Shua came and died as the great sacrifice to redeem all mankind, the book then began to be rewritten (or rewrite itself).

The rewriting of the book is a phenomena that was not anticipated by Lucifer and as such, is causing him to become most frantic in his future plans. It is clear that the 'saints' can cause the book to be rewritten in some aspects and as such, the weight of our mission of faith remains critical to the final victory of Y'Shua over Lucifer.
