Community Farm

On the morning of the 7th of December, I dreamed and found myself on a rural piece of forested property owned by a good looking blond woman. It was located with direct access to a well paved road some place in the mountains with very large evergreen trees scattered throughout the property. It was on a gentle sloping hill and not very large – perhaps 20 acres. The property seemed to have been what was left of either a large dairy farm or even a saw mill at some time in its past as it had many very large wooden barn type buildings in disrepair that may have been erected over 100 years ago. The area seemed like a warmer part of the US which would allow for comfortable RV camping even in the winter.

Mobility Vs. Permanence

The discussion I had with this lady who owned the property is her choice in either trying to fund the building of many cabins on the property in the development of a community or choosing the idea of a mobile community in allowing people to live in earth-friendly RV rigs. I said to her, “You can either find the money and take the time to build cabins or make this a mobile park and serve the needs of Gods people now.” I had been asked to meet this woman because she had set apart this property to God become a community of Christians that would seek YHWH in all things and learn the way of becoming prophets.

Hundreds in the Community

I then saw hundreds of people who were dressed like the hippies of the late 1960's and 70's wandering the place and going to a meeting in one of the barns that had been quickly renovated for community use as a meeting and dining hall. Another barn was used as a massive work shop for making crafts and other needed products. There were many other buildings used for animals and agriculture scattered on the property.

Horse Drawn Wagons

What I did find very interesting is that there were no motor vehicles seen on this farm. I did see wagon styled trailers and animals such as mules and horses. It seemed the decision was made to not rely on fossil fuel vehicles and to return to the use of draft animals to pull the wagons into hidden places in the wilderness.



Mobile Greenhouse

I met one of the residents and he showed me a greenhouse he had built on an 8' by 20' old trailer chassis. It was all glass or poly-carbonate bonded to a light wood framed built in the style of the 19th century greenhouses of England. I was very impressed and knew this person understood the need to be prepared to be mobile in all aspects of living. Even the need for a mobile food production

solution was taken into consideration and preparations were being made for a time when this would be necessary.

Balanced Mission

This mission of establishing a farm community of prophets on a farm when combined with the understanding for the need for extreme mobility seemed to be the right balance that YHWH was revealing to the many communities of prophets YHWH would establish in the present and near future. Some effort was placed in renovating existing structures for the needs of the community if they could be fixed at a very little cost. However, the major focus was in the preparation for the community to become mobile and at some future time. The model was to break up into smaller groups as manageable mobile 'teams of prophets' when the time came who would then go into the mountains and deserts to be protected by YHWH.

Prophets Targeted by Antichrist Regime
